Fr. Ross's input for an arrival announcement:

The Anglican Church of the Holy Trinity has called Ross Guthrie as our Rector beginning the last week of September 2019. The Guthrie family is moving to North Augusta from Jackson, Tennessee where Ross served as Priest of Spiritual Formation at All Saints Anglican Church since 2015. He completed a Masters of Christian Thought at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in May 2016 and was ordained a Priest in October 2016.
