Counting Days and Making Them Count Until Jesus Comes

Last week, I talked about creeds and how they are faithful expressions of its teaching. As Anglicans, we believe that all true doctrine is derived from Holy Scripture, which is the wellspring and ground for testing all that is taught in the Church. St. Paul instructs the Church, "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness" (1 Timothy 3:16). Article 6 of the Articles of Religion states, "Whatever is not read therein, nor may be proved thereby, is not to be required of any man that it should be believed as an article of the Faith."

Holy Scripture is "God's Word written", given by the Holy Spirit through prophets and apostles as the revelation of God and his acts in human history, and is therefore the Church's final authority in all matters of faith and practice. The thirty-nine books of the Old Testament and the twenty-seven books of the New Testament together form the whole of Holy Scripture. Holy Scripture is "God-breathed", for the biblical authors wrote under the guidance of God's Holy Spirit to record God's Word. May God bless your reading this week of Holy Scripture.
